Specific Regulations

Article 1. Organisation

The Chrono Gatineau and the Grand Prix Cycliste Gatineau presented by Hydro-Québec, is organized by the Corporation of La Grande Visite de Gatineau with the collaboration of the City of Gatineau, under the regulations of the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI), the Canadian Cycling Association and the Fédération québécoise des sports cyclistes (FQSC). The Chrono Gatineau is held May 19, 2010 and the Grand Prix Cycliste Gatineau presented by Hydro-Québec, May 21, 2011.

The men's, Grand Prix Cycliste Outaouais, will be held May 21, 2011 and is sanctioned by the FQSC.

Article 2. Type of Event

The Chrono Gatineau and the Grand Prix Cycliste Gatineau presented by Hydro-Québec are classed UCI WE 1.1 and count towards the UCI rankings. The following points will be awarded:
80 – 56 – 32 – 24 – 20 – 16 – 12 – 8 – 7 – 6 – 5 – 3 (12 places)

The Grand Prix Cycliste Outaouais is a men's race sanctioned by the FQSC. No UCI points are awarded.

Article 3. Participation

The Chrono Gatineau and Grand Prix Cycliste Gatineau presented by Hydro-Québec, are open to teams of UCI élite women's teams. National teams, regional and club teams. Second year Juniors can compete with the approval of their federation.

Participation in the time trial, Chrono Gatineau is limited to 36 riders. It is understood that priority will be given to national teams and UCI registered teams first. For the Grand Prix Cycliste Gatineau presented by Hydro-Québec, teams are limited to a maximum number of riders of 6 and a minimum of 4 in order to take the start.

Grand Prix Cycliste Outaouais is an individual men's road race open to Elite Senior riders, Junior men, and Master A riders ages 30-39.

Article 4. Race Headquarters

Race headquarter will be open from Wednesday May 18, 2011 at the Best Western Plus Hotel, 131 rue Laurier, Gatineau.

Team representatives are requested to confirm their riders and collect their race numbers at the race headquarters from 15h00 and attend the director's meeting at 17h00, May 18, 2011 for the Chrono Gatineau, and from 17h00, May 20, 2011 for the Grand Prix Cycliste Gatineau presented by Hydro-Québec, at 131 rue Laurier, Best Western Plus.

The Team Presentation will be at the Best Western Plus at 131 rue Laurier, May 20 from 16h00 to 17h00. All Teams are required to attend in their team colours.

The race site office will be in the «École La Génération» at 35, rue Davies.

For the Grand Prix Cycliste Outaouais, men's FQSC road race, registration will be taken on the morning of the race, Saturday May 21 at the École la Génération, 35 rue Davies.

Registration will be open from 09h00 to 13h00.

Article 5 Starting order

Starting order for Time trials will be determined by the Organizer (Chrono Gatineau).

There are 3 waves of 12 riders each.

Teams with 3 riders will have 1 in each wave to allow managers to follow each rider in the car.

For the Grand Prix Cycliste Gatineau presented by Hydro-Québec, the caravan order will be based on a random draw with UCI and National teams drawing for the first places followed by the regional and club teams drawing for the remaining positions.

Article 6. Radio-Tour

Each team car will be provided a race radio.

Race information during the race will be broadcast on channel 4.

Article 7. Neutral Service

Neutral service will be provided by the organiser. Two vehicles will be available.

Article 8. Feeding

« No Feeding will be permitted » in the CHRONO GATINEAU

Feeding in the Grand Prix Cycliste Gatineau presented by Hydro-Québec will be allowed from the caravan.

Article 9. Finishing Time Limits

Any rider finishing in a time exceeding that of the winner by more than 30% in the Chrono Gatineau and 10% in the Grand Prix Cycliste Gatineau presented by Hydro-Québec shall not be placed. The time limit may, in exceptional circumstances, be increased by the Commissaires' Panel in agreement with the organizer. (Article 2.3.039 of the UCI rules).

Article 10. Classification

The final individual classification will be determined by the order in which the riders cross the finish line.

Article 11. Prizes

For the Grand Prix Cycliste Gatineau presented by Hydro-Québec, the following prizes will be awarded according to the UCI breakdown.

Article 12. Antidoping

The UCI antidoping regulations are entirely applicable to the event. The test location is at l'École la Génération, 35 rue Davies.

Article 13. Award Ceremonies

The top three finishers must present themselves to the podium a maximum of 5 minutes after the finish of the final competitor at the end of the Chrono Gatineau Time Trial.

As we await the results of the final riders we ask that the current top 3 riders remain in the finishing area until the completion of the remaining riders determine the final classification.

For the road races, the top three must present themselves to the presentation area within 5 minutes after the finish of the Grand Prix Cycliste Gatineau presented by Hydro-Québec and the Grand Prix Cycliste Outaouais.

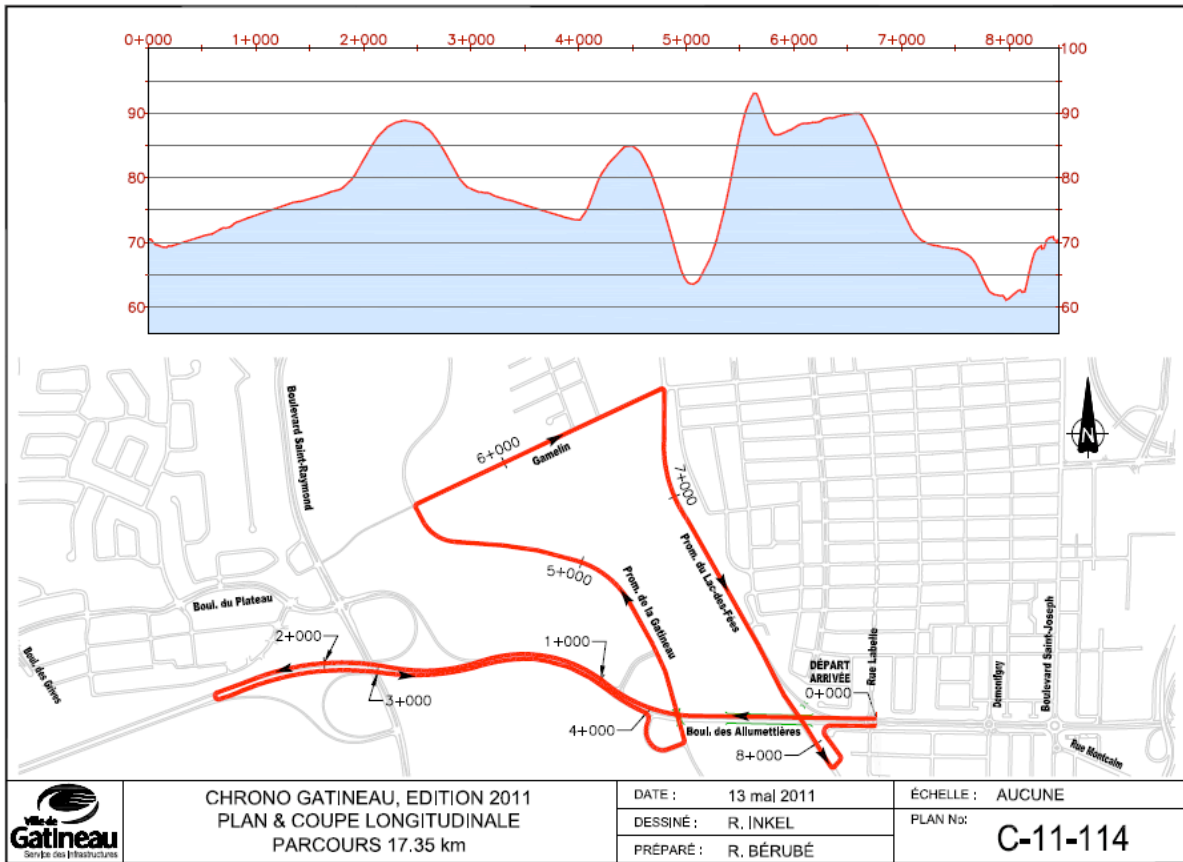

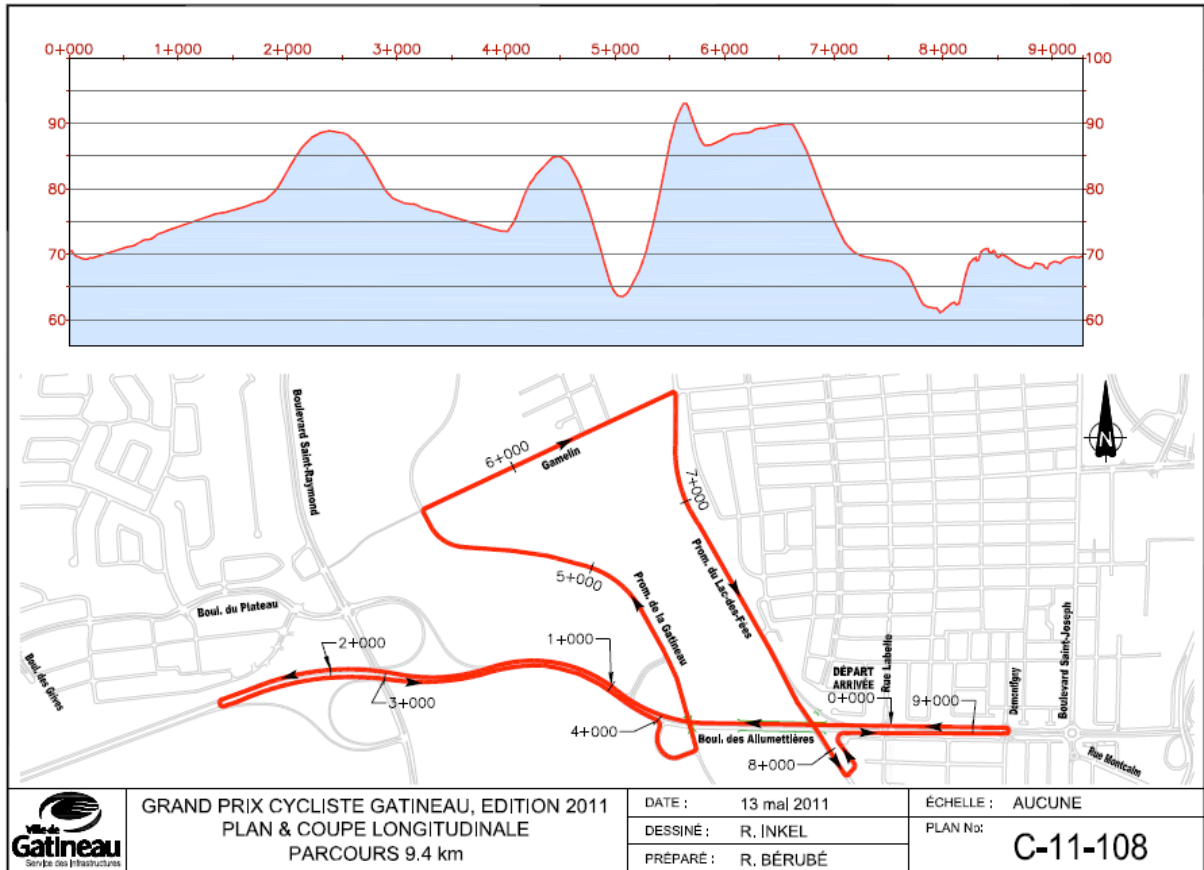
