

**CCA ATHLETES' COUNCIL**  
**ELECTION OF REPRESENTATIVES 2010**

1. Election of representatives for each of the five cycling sports (Road, Track, Para-cycling, Mountain Bike and BMX) will be done by electronic vote overseen by the Program Coordinator for each of the noted sports. Elections will be held in the fall of each year after the CCA Annual Meeting.
2. Election for a two-year term will be held every two (2) years in even-numbered years. National Team Athlete Representatives shall be chosen by election by the end of the calendar year in even years.
3. Two (2) National Team Athlete Representatives – one male and one female - from each of the following cycling sports: MTB, ROAD, TRACK, BMX, PARA-CYCLING for a total of ten. Eligibility as a National Team Representative is limited to athletes that are current members of the National Team or have been members of the National Team, for any period, within the five (5) years preceding the election (ie. the 2010 election would include 2006 National Team athletes and later).
4. All registered senior elite and U23 athletes will be eligible to vote for the position in their sport and gender.
5. Candidates must complete the attached nomination form and submit it to the Program Coordinator for their sport not later than **November 12<sup>th</sup>**. The Program Coordinator will circulate the eligible nominations to the athletes eligible to vote for the specific representative within three days of the nomination deadline. The votes should be received not later than **November 24<sup>th</sup>** and the results will be posted and communicated the following day.
6. The elected cycling sport representatives will elect a Chair and Vice-Chair to guide the Council at their first meeting. It is expected that the Chair and Vice-Chair should be from different cycling sports.
7. The Chair will attend the Board of Directors' meetings and the Vice-Chair the meetings of the High Performance Committee.
8. The Council will meet via conference call initially and determine if and when a face to face meeting would be required in discussion with the CEO and HPD.
